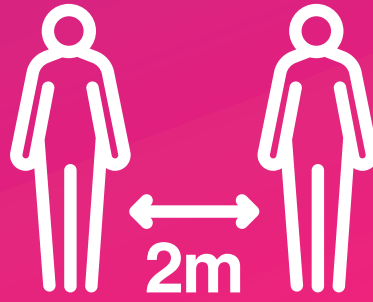


Social distancing

- Stay at least two metres away from anyone who isn't living in your household – this means friends, neighbours and our colleagues. You may see our teams carrying out emergency repairs, cleaning communal areas or gardening and maintenance.
- Remember not to meet up with family members, friends and neighbours who aren't in your household unless it's essential. And if you really have to, remember to follow the social distancing rules.

If you are worried about somebody breaking the social distancing government guidance, you have a right to report this to the police on the non-emergency number 101.
